## Why Water Baptism?

Because Water baptism is an outward testimony of what has occurred inwardly in a believer's life. It is how we identify with the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. Water Baptism is the act of being immersed in water that symbolizes dying and being buried with Christ. The action of coming out of the water pictures Christ's resurrection.

There are two requirements for a person to be baptized:

- 1) The person being baptized must have trusted in Jesus Christ as Savior.
- 2) The person must understand what baptism signifies.

According to the Bible, Christian baptism is important because it is a step of obedience, publicly declaring faith in Christ and our commitment to Him, and an identification with Christ's death, burial, and resurrection.
