

CLAREMORE NINJA WARRIOR

Event & Competition Details

Claremore Ninja Warrior itself will be a free event for the community. Entry, spectating, and trying/playing on obstacles will all be free activities. Kids and adults of **any age** who have filled out a **waiver** (available online and at the event) are welcome to try obstacles at their **own comfort level**. There will be ninja coaches and athletes on hand to help with technique and spotting. A smaller “mini ninjas course” and bounce house will be provided for kids **5 and under only**.

There will also be a competition portion of the event where competitors can attempt “full course runs,” and the best run of the night (going the farthest the fastest) will win a prize of \$500. There will be a small cost for each full-course run. Details regarding the competition are below:

- The competition will be structured like NBC’s American Ninja Warrior television show/competition and “NNL” style ninja competition – i.e. runs will be “**one and done**,” meaning that your run will continue until you fall off an obstacle or touch any ground, mats, or equipment not designated as part of the course. If you are disqualified, your run will end immediately.
- Each full-course run will cost only \$5. Competitors will pay at the start line.
- The competition portion of the event will be reserved for ages 12 and up. For clarification, the event itself and obstacle free-play are open to any age. Only the competition portion for the \$500 prize will be reserved for ages 12 and up.
- There will be **NO pre-registration and NO guaranteed runs**. The length of the competition will be based on time alone. Individuals interested in competing will form a line at the start of the course when the competition begins. We will run as many competitors as we have time for. It is possible that we will not have enough time to run all individuals who would like to compete. Runs will be first-come, first-served. We apologize in advance if that means that you do not get to run the course, but we must keep the event on schedule. If there is additional time, it is also possible that competitors could return to the back of the line and run the course multiple times to attempt to improve their time/distance.
- At the start of the competition, a brief explanation/demonstration of the course will be given. If you are competing, please pay special attention to this instruction. It is the responsibility of the competitor to be aware of the competition guidelines. Disqualification on the course will stand whether or not a competitor was paying attention to that portion of the rules.
- Competitors must have a waiver filled out and must agree to follow the guidelines therein. Claremore Ninja Warrior reserves the right to disqualify any competitor for unsportsmanlike conduct or failing to follow instruction and to modify the line as necessary to provide the best possible event for all attendees/competitors.
